Prayer Shawl: 5 x 5 Squares (25 squares are required as per the pattern below); Double Knitting Wool; 4 mm (8) needles

Pattern for each square: Garter Stich

Row 1: Cast on 1 stich.

Row 2: Make the 1 stitch into 2 stiches by knitting into front and back of stitch.

Row 3: Knit 1, increase in 2nd stitch as above....3 stiches on needle.

Continue by always knitting the 1st stitch, increasing on the second stitch at the beginning of every row until you have 50 stiches on the needle. Garter Stitch 1 row.

Now decrease by one stich at the beginning of each row, by knit 1, knit 2 together, then knit to end of row.

Continue until you have 1 stich, then cast off.

A separate pattern is available for the praying hands square.
